We are busy preparing the final route information and this will be sent out to you in two weeks along with your rally plates. A copy of the latest entry list is enclosed, please check that we have your details correct and most importantly that you have been entered into the correct route category.

Final Hotel

In order to give you a proper Irish finish we have changed our final night to Trim. We'll be based at the newly built Trim Castle Hotel which is in the heart of the town. The castle is the largest Anglo-Norman castle in Ireland and was the setting for the film Braveheart. Frank and Keith are planning a second evening section for you - this time on foot after the presentation dinner. In view of this we have decided that as the wearing of a black tie may hamper your enjoyment of the local hostelrys the dress code for dinner will just become "smart".

Maps

We have had several enquiries regarding whether it is necessary to have the latest edition of the maps, in most cases it probably isn't but you may find a couple of road colours which vary. However, for the sections of route that you do not receive in advance you may want to ensure you have the latest maps. The numbers for the navigation and evening section are: 1, 2, 11, 26, 27 and 28.

Regulations

Please do take the time to read the regulations before the event, I know they are rather

tedious but it is important that you understand the penalty structure. If you have any queries please don't hesitate to get in touch before the event or there will be chance to ask questions before the start.

Insurance

Please check your existing motor insurance policies to see that you are covered for a regularity rally, you may be asked to show evidence of cover at Documentation. If your existing policy does not cover regularity rallies you will probably be able to take advantage of the scheme provided by Motor Sports Risk Services. As long as you can satisfy the following criteria:

- 1) No more than 1 fault accident in the last 3 years.
- 2) No convictions other than a maximum of 6 speeding points.
- 3) No physical or mental disabilities.
- 4) No material facts to disclose.

Cover can be provided for a premium of approximately £62. If you are unsure whether you satisfy these criteria please request a proposal form which must be completed and submitted to the brokers.

Trailers

Can anybody who requires trailer parking please contact us as soon as possible so we may discuss arrangements.

Ferries

We have had contact with the vast majority of you regarding ferry crossings but if there is anybody else who'd like to make a booking please do contact us as soon as possible.

Speed Tables

Entrants will need a set of average speed tables covering the range 30 to 48kph, these are available from Don Barrow - Tel +44 1625 429092 or www.DonBarrow.co.uk whilst you are talking to Don you could also order yourself a new romer - not needed for Clubmen competitors

Tyres

Could we please remind you that current Historic Motorsport Regulations in the UK and Ireland require the use of tyres with a profile of at least 70%. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in a penalty being applied. We have made representations to the MSA to have this regulation revised but to no avail.

Hotels and Baggage Van

The data sheet details whether you have booked pre start accommodation or single rooms. If you haven't done so to date and wish to do so please contact us as soon as possible. This also applies to requests for space on the baggage van.

Rally School

Instead of a pre event school we have decided to run a session on the Saturday afternoon for Clubmen competitors, can you please let us know if you'd like to attend.
