## Ferries and Hotels

For this event a combined Ferry and Hotel Package is being offered by the Isle of Man Steam Packet Company, at the time of writing there were quite a number of people who had not yet booked a package, this may be because you have already made individual arrangements. If you do intend to utilise the offered package we'd suggest you do try and get your booking in as soon as possible as there is a finite number of places available and the Thursday / Sunday crossings will be the ones that most competitors want to use.

## Scrutineering

If you are intending to travel across to the Island on Wednesday please do let us know and we will arrange a scrutineering session in advance of the ferries arrival on Thursday to ease the number of cars to be scrutineered on Thursday evening.

## Route Information

The intention with the Three Legs of Mann is to keep the time that navigators spend poring over maps to a minimum in order that everyone can enjoy the delights of this pretty little island. A tulip road book for the route linking the "Special tests" and "Regularity sections" will be issued at documentation on Thursday, together with all the test diagrams.

The remaining information will be issued as follows:-

Leg 1 - Issued at the Mount Murray Hotel (Rally HQ) 1 hour before your due start time from MTC 1/1 Nobles Park.

Leg 2 - Issued at MTC 1/6 Mount Murray Hotel (supper halt)

Leg 3 - Issued at the Mount Murray Hotel (Rally HQ) 1 hour before your due time at MTC 3/1 (Mount Murray Hotel).

As some of the roads on the island are used more than once during the event and possibly in different directions most navigators should find it simpler to read the route for the link sections directly from the tulips rather than attempt to transfer information onto what may become a rather cluttered map.

The information for the "Regularity and TC sections" issued at the locations above, will be in a variety of formats but in all cases we will try to make them as "user friendly" as possible. Where marked maps are used these will be colour copies of the 1:50,000 scale O.S. Landranger sheet 95.

## Insurance

Please check your existing motor insurance policies to see that you are covered for a regularity rally, you may be asked to show evidence of cover at Documentation. If your existing policy does not cover regularity rallies you may be able to take advantage of a group scheme. If you are interested in this option please let us know.
